

## You may be eligible for Veterans healthcare benefits if you:

Served in the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps or Coast Guard on Active Duty

Served in the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps (WAAC) during 1942—1943

Flew as a Women's Air Force Service Pilot (WASP) during World War II

Worked as a telephone operator, clerk, dietitian or reconstruction aide with the Army in Europe during World War II

### How to Access Service

All honorably discharged women Veterans are eligible to apply for healthcare services. If you have received VA care since 1996, you are automatically enrolled. If not, you can either visit the Business Office or call for an enrollment package. A co-payment may be charged for some services if they are not for service-connected conditions. The fee is determined by your income.
